Knitting Pattern

Poppy Petals

using red yarn- Cast on 5st

Rw1. K(5)
Rw2. Kfb, K3, Kfb (7)
Rw3. Kfb, K5, Kfb (9)
Rw4. Kfb, K7, Kfb (11)
Rw5-8. K (11)
Rw9. K2tog, K7, K2tog (9)
Rw10-12. K (9)
Rw13. K2tog, K5, K2tog (7)
Rw14. K2tog, K3, K2tog (5)
Rw15-16. K (5)
Rw17. Kfb, K3, Kfb (7)
Rw18. Kfb, K5, Kfb (9)
Rw19. K (9)
Rw20. Kfb, K7, Kfb (11)
Rw21. K (11)
Rw22. Kfb, K9, Kfb (13)
Rw23. K (13)
Rw24. K2tog, K9, K2tog (11)
Rw25. K2tog, K7, K2tog (9)
Rw26. K2tog, K5, K2tog (7)
Rw27. Cast off and sew in loose ends.

Middle of Poppy

Using black yarn - Cast on 2 st

Rw1. Kfb x2 (4)
Rw2. Kfb, K2, Kfb (6)
Rw3-4. K (6)
Rw5. K2tog, K2, K2tog (4)
Rw6. K2tog x2 (2)
Rw7. Cast off sew in loose ends and adjoin to poppy petals.

Key:

K- Knit
K2tog- Knit two stitches together
Kfb- Knit into the front and back loop of the stitch - increase.

KEY

Abbreviations (American)	British equivalent
Ch - chain	chain
SC- single crochet	double crochet
DC - double crochet	treble crochet
Slst- slip stitch	slip stitch

Hook: 4mm (Any size hook can be used, it will just alter size of poppy)

CROCHET PATTERN

Using Red Yarn

1. Magic ring 5st into loop, tighten.
2. 2sc in each stitch around join with slst into next stitch.
3. ch2, 2dc in next 4 sc, ch2, ss into next stitch, ch2, 1dc in to same sc, 2dc in next 3 sc, dc, ch2 and slst into same sc, slst in to next sc.
4. Fasten off, and sew in edges you can either produce the middle of the poppy as below or with a small black button.

5. Magic ring 5st into loop, slst into next sc, tighten and fasten off.
